I regret to inform you that the Comprehensive Logistics Company will be permanently closing its plant located at 365 & 375 Victoria Road, Austintown, Ohio 44515. This unfortunate situation follows the November statement that General Motors announced plans to close five U.S. plants in 2019, including the Lordstown assembly plant in Warren.

The Comprehensive Logistics facility located in Austintown, Ohio is 10 miles from Lordstown. The facility's sole responsibility is to feed parts to positions on the Lordstown assembly line. Our inception began in warehousing then adding other value-added services and later transitioned to include value added assembly. We have grown the business and have exceeded expectation on many fronts. CLI has been committed to servicing their Lordstown customer, which began in the late nineties through present day. During the past 30 plus years the company has relied heavily on the dedication of its workforce that has worked through the transition of the Cavalier, Cobalt, and now Cruze. These changes have resulted in many changeovers and implementation of great continuous improvement projects.

Comprehensive Logistics truly regrets that these actions are necessary. We deeply appreciate the loyalty of our employees and will help our workers find other employment by working closely with the Office of Workforce Development (ODJFS). Over the course of the next month we will invite this group, along with other outside agencies, into our facility to provide information to our workforce.

The Ohio's Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Dislocated Worker Program helps laid-off workers obtain new jobs who have been affected by business closures.
